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## **JUSTIFICATION**

Changes to the Law educational program are due to the need to harmonize the content of the program, approved by the decision of the Academic Council of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University dated May 25, 2017, protocol No. 5 (entered into force on September 1, 2017 by Order No. 348 of May 26, 2017 ), with the approved Standard of Higher Education in specialty 081 "Law" for the second (master's) level of higher education (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 1053 of 08/17/2020).

In the process of implementing the educational program (implementation of the curriculum, development of work programs of educational disciplines, practical training and attestation of applicants) during 2017-2021, the security group received feedback from the scientific and pedagogical staff, the academic community, and applicants of education, heads of practice bases and employers with recommendations on improving individual components of the educational program. Thus, taking into account the Standard of Higher Education in the specialty 081 "Law" for the second (master's) level, the feedback and recommendations received, changes were made to:

- general information about the educational program,
- the list of program competencies of the graduate,
- study results,
- forms of attestation of students of higher education,
- a list of educational components and their logical sequence.

The specified changes led to the development of a new edition of the description of the educational program.

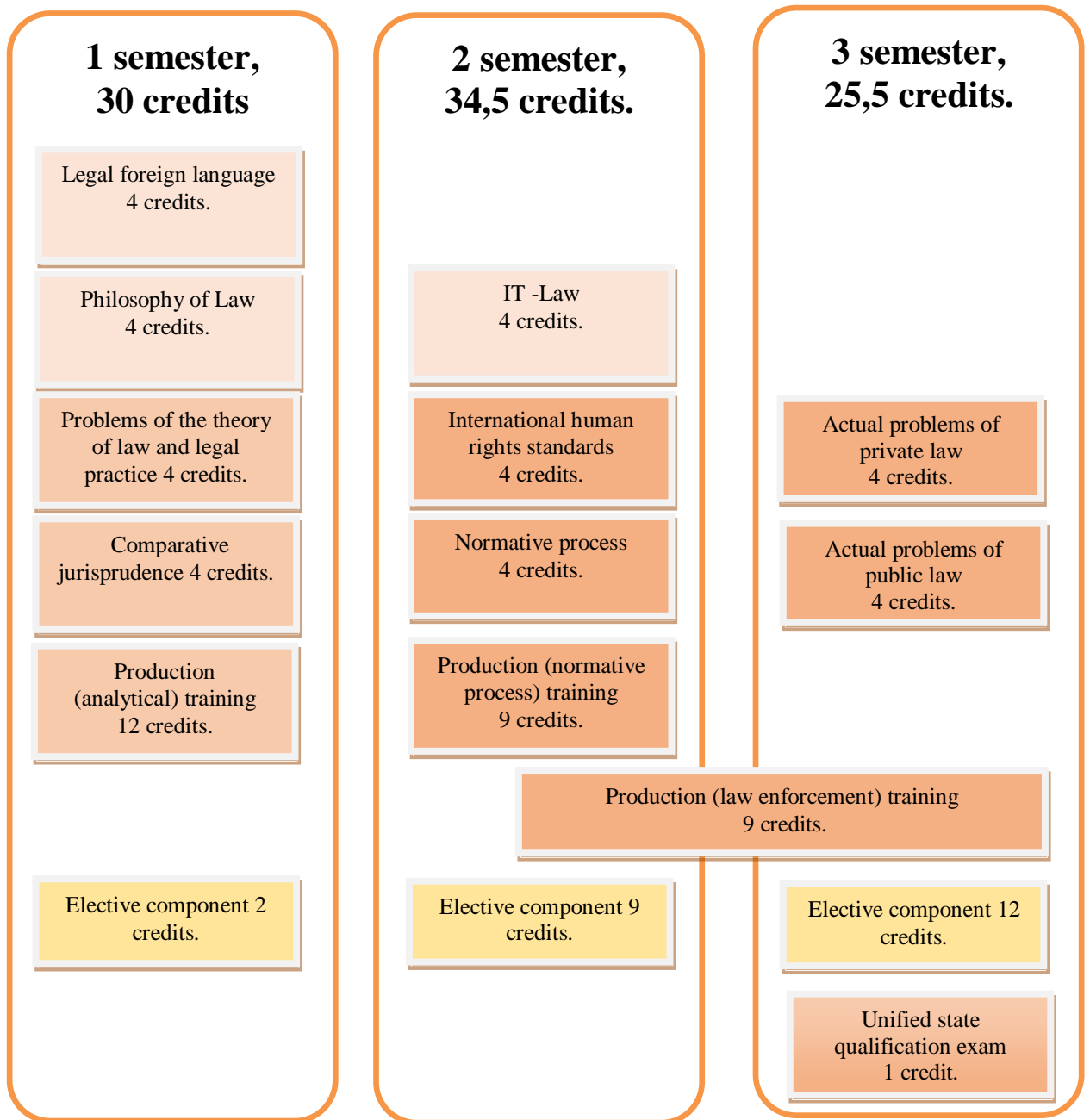

## **Appendix 1 - ELECTIVE PART OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**

The right to free choice of academic disciplines, provided for in clause 15 of the first part of Article 62 of the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education", is implemented in Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University in accordance with the Regulation on the procedure and conditions for students' choice of academic disciplines, approved by order dated 25.11.2016 No. 642.

### **The choice from the catalog of courses**

The choice of disciplines from the list (course catalog) taking into account one's own needs and interests in future professional activity allows the student to deepen his knowledge and acquire additional general and general professional competences within related specialties and fields of knowledge and/or to familiarize himself with the current level of scientific research in other fields knowledge and expand or deepen knowledge of general competencies.
