## JUSTIFICATION

Changes to the Law educational and professional program are due to the need to harmonize the content of the program, approved by the decision of the Academic Council of the Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University of August 26, 2021, protocol No. 7 (entered into force on September 1, 2021 by Order No. 528 of August 26, 2021), with the approved Standard of Higher Education in specialty 081 "Law" for the second (master's) level of higher education (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 643 dated 07/20/2022).

During the implementation of the educational and professional program (implementation of the curriculum, development of work programs of educational disciplines, practical training and certification) during the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021, 2021-2022 academic years, the group received feedback from the scientific-pedagogical staff, the academic community, education seekers, managers of practice bases and employers with recommendations for improving individual components of the educational program.

Thus, taking into account the Standard of Higher Education in the specialty 081 "Law" for the second (master's) level, received feedback and recommendations, changes were made to:

- general information about the educational program;
- the list of graduate competencies;
- names of academic disciplines.

The specified changes led to the development of a new version of the description of the educational and professional program.

## 2 – The purpose of the educational program

To prepare specialists who possess fundamental and professional knowledge and developed practical skills in the field of law, ready for self-development and professional growth.

## 3 – Characteristics of the educational program

### Description of the subject area

**The object of study:** law as a social phenomenon and the peculiarities of its application, which are based on legal values and principles, which are based on human dignity and the rule of law.

**Learning goals:** acquiring the ability to solve complex tasks and problems in the field of law-making and law enforcement and/or in the learning process, which involves conducting research and/or implementing innovations and is characterized by the uncertainty of conditions and requirements.

**Methods, techniques and technologies:** general scientific and special methods of learning legal phenomena; methods of legal assessment of the behavior or activity of individuals and social groups, identification of a legal problem and its solution based on the principles of law; digital technologies, methods of evaluation and analysis of information, methods of proof.

**Tools and equipment:** modern information and communication equipment, information resources and special software used in activities in the field of law.

### Structure

The amount of the educational program in ECTS credits is 90 credits, of which:- mandatory part (67 credits) aimed at providing general and special (professional) competences, which includes academic disciplines (36 credits), industrial practice (30 credits) and certification exam (1 credit); – elective part (23 credits, 25%) – elective subjects – full-time form of education
