### **Block 1 - Management of social projects and programs**

The student's choice of the block "Management of social projects and programs" creates conditions for the deepening of professional competencies within the selected educational and professional program.

The study of disciplines of this block is aimed at acquiring the ability of students to: determine the need for social innovation, organizational and methodological support of social initiatives at the community and organization levels; develop and organize the implementation of social projects and programs; carry out strategic and operational management of the organization that implements projects and provides social services; organize the activities of teams of social workers and representatives of other professions involved in the implementation of social projects and the provision of social services; initiate proposals for regulatory and legal support of social work and the system of integrated social services in the community; act in accordance with the professional identity and values of social work.

During the study of disciplines of the block "Management of social projects and programs" applicants for the second (master's) level of higher education will:

- get acquainted with the basic approaches to social design, strategies and models of social project management;
- acquire the skills necessary for the application of modern methods and forms of organization of project activities, team facilitation, team management, management decisions;
- develop the ability for leadership, teamwork and project management;
- master modern approaches to the implementation of the principles of inclusion and building a favorable social space in the community and organization.
