JUSTIFICATION

Changes to the educational and professional program are due to the need to align the content of the educational and professional program 025.00.02 "Solo Singing", approved by the decision of the Academic Council of the Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University of 27.04.2017 Minutes No. 5 (Order No. 348 of 26.05.2017), taking into account the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine of 04.03.2020 No. 368 On Approval of the Standard of Higher Education in specialty 025 "Musical Art" for the second (Master's) level of education.

In addition, in the process of implementing the educational program (implementation of the curriculum, development of work programs of academic courses, conducting practical training and certification) during the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021 academic years the support group received feedback from lecturers, students, heads of practice bases and employers with a number of suggestions for improving certain components of the educational and professional program.

Thus, in accordance with the Standard of Higher Education in specialty 025 "Musical Art" for the second (Master's) level of higher education and feedback from stakeholders, the following sections were developed and amended:

- general information about the educational program (the qualification is specified),
- list of program competencies;
- learning results;

The teaching staff of the Department of Philosophy of the Faculty of History and Philosophy, Foreign Languages and Methodology of the Pedagogical Institute is involved in teaching individual courses in accordance with their competencies. The practice-oriented nature of the educational program involves wide participation of practitioners, corresponding to the speciality, which enhances the synergy of practical and theoretical training. The personnel support of the educational program meets the requirements defined by the licensing conditions for the implementation of educational activities of educational institutions. The teaching of academic courses is carried out in general and special purpose classrooms. A sufficient number of specialized computer classes that are equipped with computers with appropriate software, multimedia equipment complexes, modern information security technology, microprocessor systems based on the main platforms (Arduino, RaspberryPi, Galileo), 3D printer and scanner, training network equipment (including Cisco, Dell). All workplaces in computer classrooms are connected to the Internet. The premises for individual classroom classes are equipped with professional technical equipment: acoustic systems "Alto", mixing consoles								
		"Yamaha", sound amplifying systems "Beringer EPA-900", microphones and material equipment: microphone stands, piano "Ukraine", "Weinbach", Petrof", grand piano "Estonia". Lecture halls with information and communication technical equipment (computers, SMART Boards). Practical Training Center: Training Laboratory of Performing Skills. The technical equipment of the educational process is sufficient to conduct classes according to the program. There are own social infrastructure facilities (canteen, buffets, dormitories, assembly halls, sports halls, stadium, sports grounds,
