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JUSTIFICATION

Changes to the educational-professional program are due to the need to coordinate the content of the educational-professional program 291.00.02 "Regional Studies", approved by the decision of the Academic Council of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University 27.04.2017, protocol № 4 (order № 348 from 26.05.2017) .) with the approved Standard of higher education of Ukraine of the first (bachelor's) level in the field of knowledge 29 "International Relations" specialty 291 "International Relations, Public Communications and Regional Studies" (order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine from 04.08.2020 № 1002 "On approval of the standard of higher education in the specialty 291 "International Relations, Public Communications and Regional Studies" for the first (bachelor's) level of higher education ").

In addition, in the process of implementing the educational program (implementation of the curriculum, development of work programs of disciplines, practical training and certification) during the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020 academic years, the support group received feedback from teachers, students, heads of practice bases and employers with a number of wishes to optimize the educational and professional program. Thus, in accordance with the standard of higher education in the specialty 291 International Relations, Public Communications and Regional Studies for the first (bachelor's) level of higher education and feedback from stakeholders, the following sections were developed and amended:

III. Form of certification of applicants for higher education

Qualification work involves the independent solution of a complex specialized problem or practical problem in the field of international relations and / or regional studies, in particular, which is characterized by complexity and uncertainty of conditions, using theories and methods of social sciences.

Qualification work must be checked for academic plagiarism, fabrication and falsification and published in the University repository.

The comprehensive examination in professional communication in a foreign language involves testing the achievement of learning outcomes (PRN12) in professional oral and written translation from / into foreign languages, in particular, in professional topics of international cooperation, foreign policy, international communications, regional studies, bilateral and multilateral international projects.

Certification is carried out openly and publicly. Атестація здійснюється відкрито і публічно.

Implementation of the educational-professional program in full ends with the issuance to the graduate of a standard document on awarding him a bachelor's degree with the qualification: Bachelor of International Relations, Public Communications and Regional Studies.
