JUSTIFICATION

Changes to the educational and professional program are made due to the need to harmonize the content of the educational and professional program 291.00.01 "Public Communications", approved by the decision of the Academic Council of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University from 27.04.2017, protocol № 4 (order № 348 from 26.05.2017) with the approved Standard of higher education of Ukraine of the first (bachelor's) level in the field of knowledge 29 "International Relations" specialty 291 "International Relations, Public Communications and Regional Studies" (order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine from 04.08.2020 № 1002 "On approval of the standard of higher education in the specialty 291" International Relations, Public Communications and Regional Studies "for the first (bachelor) level of higher education").

In addition, during the implementation of the educational program (implementation of the curriculum, development of work programs of disciplines, practical training and certification) during the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020 academic years, the support group received feedback from teachers, students, heads of practice bases and employers with a number of wishes to optimize the educational and professional program. 3. Form of certification of applicants for higher education

Certification of graduates of the educational program 291.00.01 Public communications is carried out in the form:

- protection of qualifying bachelor's thesis;
- comprehensive exam in professional communication in a foreign language.

A bachelor's thesis involves the independent solution of a complex specialized problem or practical problem in the field of international relations and public communications, which is characterized by complexity and uncertainty of conditions, using theories and methods of social sciences.

Qualifying undergraduate work must be tested for academic plagiarism and must be published in the University repository.

The comprehensive exam in professional communication in a foreign language involves checking the achievement of learning outcomes (PLO12) in professional oral and written translation from / into foreign languages, in particular, in professional topics of international cooperation, foreign policy, international communications, bilateral and multilateral international projects.

Certification is carried out openly and publicly.
