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JUSTIFICATION

Changes to the educational and professional program 081.00.01 Law are due to the need to agree on the content of the educational and professional program, approved by the Academic Council of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University from April 24, 2017, protocol № 4 (enacted on September 1, 2017 by order of May 25, 2017 № 348), with the approved Standard in the specialty 081 Law for the first (bachelor's) level of higher education (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine № 1379 of 12.12.2018).

In the process of implementing the educational program (implementation of the curriculum, development of programs of disciplines, practical training and certification) during the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020 academic years, the support group received feedback from the scientific and pedagogical staff, the academic community, students, heads of practice bases and employers with a number of wishes to improve certain disciplines of the educational and professional program. Thus, taking into account the Standard in the specialty 081 Law for the first (bachelor's) level of higher education, received feedback and recommendations, changes were made to:

- general information about the educational program,
- list of competencies of the graduates,
- program learning outcomes,
- list of disciplines of the educational-professional program and their logical sequence,
- forms of certification of applicants for higher education.

These changes led to the development of a new version of the description of the educational and professional program.
