Justification

Changes to the educational and professional programs 012.00.01 Preschool Education (short-term training program) of the first (Bachelor's) level of higher education are due to the need to coordinate the content of the educational and professional program, approved by the decision of the Academic Council of the Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University of May 30, 2019, Minutes No. 5, and launched from 01.09.2019 (Order No. 383 of 30.05.2019) with approved Standard of Higher Education in Ukraine: first (Bachelor's) level of higher education, field of knowledge 01 - "Education/Pedagogy", specialty 012 "Preschool Education" (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No 1456 of 21.11.2019), approved new version of the State Standard of Preschool Education (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No 33 of 12.01.2020), approved Professional Standard "Educator of Preschool Education Institution" (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 755-21 of 19.10.2021), the current version of the National Classifier of Ukraine (classifier of professions ДК 003:2010 with amendments and additions approved by the Order of the Ministry of Economy of Ukraine No 810 of 25.10.2021), as well as individual factors that appeared in the process of implementing the educational and professional program (curriculum, development of educational programs for academic courses and practical training) during the 2019-2020, 2020-2021, 2021-2022 academic years.

In accordance with the current Standard of Higher Education for the specialty 012 Preschool Education for the first (Bachelor's) level of higher education, the current State Standard of Preschool Education, the current Professional Standard "Educator of a Preschool Educational Institution", the current version of the National Classifier of Ukraine, the EPP 012.00.01 Preschool Education (short-term training program) of the first (Bachelor's) level of higher education has the following clarifications of the following sections:

- Profile of the educational program (general information; eligibility of graduates for employment and further study; list of competencies; normative content of training applicants for higher education, learning results; resource support for the implementation of the educational program)
 - List of EPP components and their logical sequence;
 - Form of certification of applicants for higher education

After the introduction of the Standard of Higher Education for the specialty 012.00.01 "Preschool Education" for the first (Bachelor's) level of higher education, new version of the State Standard of Preschool Education, new Professional Standard "Educator of a Preschool Educational Institution", new version of the National Classifier of Ukraine, consultations and working meetings with stakeholders, a survey of applicants for higher education, the Working Group agreed on the following amendments:

3. Characteristics of the educational program

Description of the subject area

Objects of the study and activities – education of children from birth to school admission; development of ideas, skills, and qualities necessary for the formation of a holistic, realistic picture of the child's world and the basics of the worldview; methodological and technological tools for the formation of competencies of a preschool child.

Learning objectives – training of specialists to form competencies or provide educational services for children of early and preschool age in institutions of the education system and family, able to solve complex specialized tasks characterized by complexity and uncertainty of conditions with the application of fundamental and relevant achievements of the theory and practice of preschool education.

The theoretical content of the subject area is based on proven and effective scientific results, taking into account the current achievements of pedagogical science, focuses on modern technologies of competence-based, personality-oriented, and vitagenic education, providing graduates with the opportunity for further professional and scientific careers; is based on the following concepts: preschool education, the development of children of early and preschool age, the leading type of activities of early and preschool age children, psychological and pedagogical support, educational interaction with children of early and preschool age, the educational process of preschool educational institutions, the formation of competencies of preschool children; focuses on mastering the skills of applying modern educational technologies in real conditions.

Methods, techniques and technologies — auditory, visual, Socratic, problem, research, practical, inductive, deductive; axiological methods, immersion lectures, SAF (methods of conducting seminars in an active form), organization of coursework projecting, knowledge and skill assessment; self-development technologies, critical thinking, project, differentiated, interactive, distance learning, health-saving, eco-, art-, information and communication, communication and speech, social and communication, diagnostic, propaedeutic, personality-oriented, and gamification technologies.

Section III. Form of certification of applicants for higher education
