The educational and scientific program "Philosophy" for training doctors of philosophy (field of knowledge 03 Humanities, specialty 033 Philosophy) was developed by researchers of the Department of Philosophy and Religious Studies of the Faculty of Social sciences and Humanities.

The educational and scientific program "Philosophy" was developed taking into account the new educational strategy adopted at the Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University. The peer-reviewed program reflects the main components and stages of training a competitive specialist capable of performing research and analytical and prognostic functions. It clearly defines the purpose and results of training, which are the basis for the formation of general and special competencies.

The goals of the program correspond to the mission and strategy of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University. As can be seen from the content of the program, the research component is the key imperative for the formation of relevant competencies and program results. It provides for the successful conduct of one's own theoretical and philosophical research.

The uniqueness of the program lies in the implementation of the principle of multi-aspect integration of the content of educational training: equal integration of the general, professional and selective components of the educational process, the combination of the applicant's scientific interests with the mission and educational tasks of the University and current social demands in the field of philosophy.

The developers of the programme have thoroughly studied and used the experience of similar foreign PhD programs, which became possible thanks to the internship of the teaching staff of the department of philosophy and religious studies in foreign universities.

Educational program Philosophy (PhD) provides training of researchers in the field of knowledge 03 Humanities (Ukrainian scale) through the formation of theoretical and methodological, research, foreign language competences. It creates conditions for the self-realization of applicants, the development of scientific thinking, promotes the development of innovative philosophical ideas and projects, and provides for the successful implementation of the topic of scientific research.

It is based on the principles of systemic, integrative and competence-based approaches, it involves the development of general and professional competences, the ability to conduct scientific research in the field of Philosophy, the ability to solve practical social problems, the analysis of educational processes using current methods and technologies.

The volume of the educational and scientific program is 60 ECTS, which fully meets the requirements.

The program contains important blocks of disciplines: (1) Philosophy and methodology of scientific activity; (2) Strategies of scientific research; (3) Scientific communication in a foreign language; (4) Pedagogy and psychology of the higher education; (5) Actual problems of philosophical discourse.

All the named subjects are prerequisites, which are supplemented by practices and collectively form the skills needed for modern researchers in field of Philosophy.

Thus, the educational program presented for review may be implemented for the training of foreign students at the Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University.
