Education that offers all young people and other learners competences adapted to the specific context in which they live and allows them to actively participate in social and professional life


The degree of fulfillment of requirements regarding the educational process and its effects, formulated by stakeholders, taking into account internal and external conditions

Why is the quality of education important?


The effects of the education affect both the economy, public finances, as well as health and safety of the society. And vice versa: the condition of the economy has a measurable impact on the financing of education, and technological progress allows the use of modern technologies in education.
