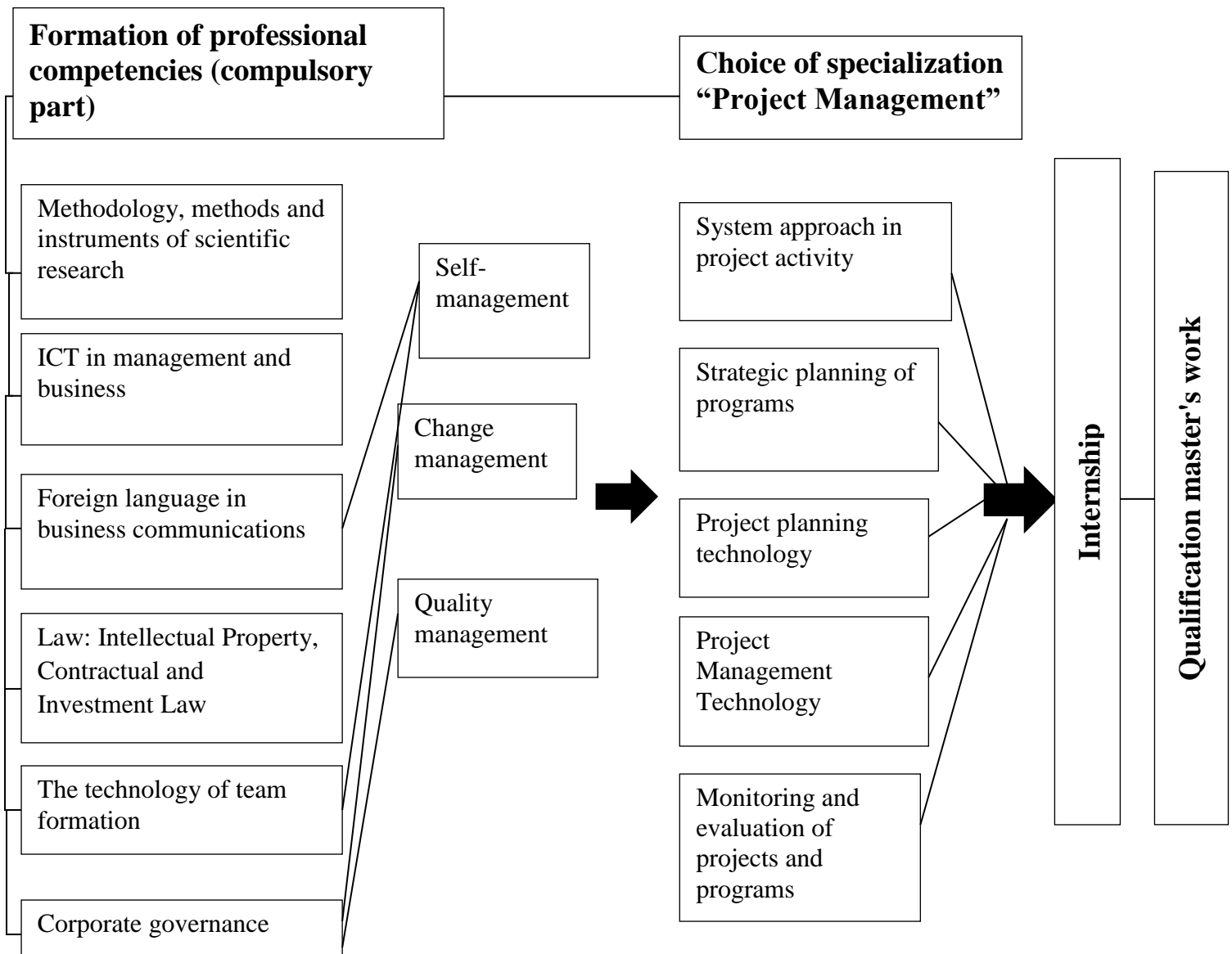

* - According to the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education", higher education graduates have the right to "select disciplines within the limits provided for by the

relevant educational program and working curriculum in the amount of not less than 25 percent of the total number of ECTS credits provided for this higher level education. At the same time applicants of a certain level of higher education have the right to choose the study disciplines offered for other levels of the higher education, in agreement with the head of the faculty or unit.

III. Form of Attestation of Higher Educational Learners

The certification of the graduate of the programme of study (vocational) of Specialty 073 "Management" is carried out in the form of the defense of the master's work and ends with the issuance of the document of the established sample on awarding learners a master's degree with the qualification of "Master of Management" in Specialty "Management of Organizations and Administration". The certification is carried out openly and publicly.

The defense of the master's thesis is an independent final research qualification written work, which confirms the corresponding level of theoretical knowledge and practical training, as well as the ability to work independently in the chosen specialty. Master's work is one of the types of individual student work, an original, completed academic research in the field of knowledge "Management and Administration" and contains a set of results, provisions that are proposed for public protection.

Master's work is carried out in accordance with the directions of scientific and applied research and should certify: the level of professional training of the graduate; the ability to use the knowledge gained at a higher educational institution to solve complex scientific and practical tasks; conscious assimilation of knowledge and their systematization; presence of a student's skills in scientific work; ability to think critically and creatively and ability to argue their own point of view.

On the basis of the protection of the master's work, the Examining Committee decide on the awarding the qualification to its author and on the issuance of a Master's Diploma.
