To prepare competent competitive specialists in the field of international relations capable of providing information and analytical activities in the system of central and local government bodies, diplomatic establishments, international organizations and private structures that carry out international activities; to form the relevant competencies for further education and development.

3 - Characteristics of the programme of study

Subject area

Objects of study and /or activity:

International relations, foreign policy of states, international organizations, international communications, states and international regions in interactions at the global, regional and local levels, international security and conflicts, information and analytical activities.

Learning objectives: to gain profound knowledge of the theory and practice of international relations, foreign policy, international security, international communications, development of international regions; to get qualifications for comprehensive analysis of international relations and foreign policy of states, as well as for effective work in the areas of foreign policy and international cooperation, at international organizations.

The theoretical content of the subject area is obtaining knowledge of the theory of international relations, forms and methods of their organization, history and current practice of international cooperation, interaction and competition, nature and dynamics of international security, international conflicts, systems and sources of foreign policy of the state, comprehensive knowledge of countries and regions, nature and evolution of international communication and international information space.

Methods, techniques and technologies:

collecting and analysing information in the field of international relations, foreign policy, international security, international communications; determining the sources and directions for development of international relations in various spheres; using the method of abstract thinking, analysis and synthesis; methods of system analysis, event analysis, content analysis, modelling, forecasting of international processes; methods and means of computer science, computer data processing; information, software and communication technologies; using proficient foreign languages for professional activities.

Instruments and equipment: computer and network programmable devices.
