### **3. Form of Attestation of Higher Education Learners**

The attestation of graduate students of specialty 239 International Law consists of:

- 1) public presentation of a bachelor's paper;
- 2) complex examination in a foreign (English) language.

The attestation is completed by issuing a standardized document on awarding a person, who successfully accomplished the educational program of a bachelor's degree with assignment of their qualification: Bachelor of international law.
