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JUSTIFICATION

Changes to the educational and professional program 081.00.01 The right are conditioned by the need to harmonize the content of the educational and professional program, approved by the decision of the Academic Council of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University of April 24, 2017, protocol No. 4 (entered into force on September 1, 2017 by order of May 25, 2017 No. 348. The new edition of the indicated educational and professional program was approved by the decision of the Academic Council of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University of September 24, 2020, protocol No. 8), with the approved Standard for the specialty 081 Law for the first (bachelor) level of higher education (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 644 dated 07/20/2022 with changes introduced in accordance with the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 307 dated 03/20/2023).

During the implementation of the educational program (implementation of the curriculum, development of work programs of educational disciplines, practical training and certification) during the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021, 2021-2022 academic years, the support group received feedback from scientific and pedagogical staff, the academic community, students of education, managers of practice bases and employers with a number of wishes regarding the improvement of individual components of the educational and professional program. Thus, taking into account the Standard for the specialty 081 Law for the first (bachelor) level of higher education No. 644 of 07/20/2022 with changes made in accordance with the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 307 of 03/20/2023, received wishes, changes were made in:
