### **III. Graduates' Certification**

The certification is open and public.

On the basis of acquired professional competences specified in special units of subjects and practices of this curriculum, held in compliance with the terms and conditions, and successful final certification, the Examination Board is mandated to award a professional qualification "Teacher of a general secondary education institution" of Ukrainian language and literature, foreign literature.

To award professional qualification "Teacher of a general secondary education institution" it is necessary to master the competences formed in the process of acquiring academic subjects of professional training CSP.07 – Methodology of teaching linguistic and literary subjects in general secondary education institutions (standard level), CSP.08 – Methodology of teaching linguistic and literary subjects in general secondary education institutions (specialized level), teaching practices CP.01 – Professional (teaching in senior school) and presentation of a Master paper.
