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#### JUSTIFICATION

Changes to educational and professional programs 024.00.01 Choreography is due to the need to coordinate the content of the educational and professional program approved by the decision of the Academic Council of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University from 25.05.2017 Minutes No. 5 (Order No. 348 of 26.05.2017) and the approved Standard of higher education in the specialty 024 "Choreography" for the second (master's) level of higher education (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No 359 of 04.03.2020), as well as several factors that turned out to be in the process of implementing the educational program (implementation of the curriculum, development of working programs of academic disciplines, practical training and certification of applicants) during the 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021 academic years.

In addition, during the implementation of the educational program, the support group received feedback from teachers, students, heads of practice bases and employers with a number of suggestions for optimizing certain components of the educational and professional program.

Thus, in accordance with the Standard of higher education in specialty 024 "Choreography" for the second (Master's) level of higher education and feedback from stakeholders, the following sections were developed and amended:

- general information about the educational program (the qualification is specified),
- list of program competencies of the graduate,
- learning results,
- list of components of the educational and professional program and their logical sequence.
- form of certification of applicants for higher education

These changes led to the development of a new version of the description of the educational and professional program.
